We also ask that you please remain out of the Bag Room and let the boys get your equipment for you. You have all been doing a great job so far so please let's work hard at keeping it going!

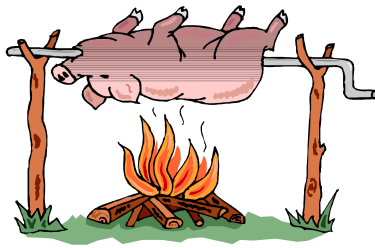
